Title: ON THE BRINK OF BELIEF, JOHN 3:1-17 (Chatham, NJ; 03/16/14, AM) [E – Exegesis]

Theme: Above all other things, the love of God changes hearts and inspires people to believe.

Purpose: To encourage the audience to let God's love into their hearts and by believing this can commence to allow Him to change them.

Introduction:

- 1. Begin in verse sixteen: think of God's love as a horizon around which all else becomes a part of the view or a canvas that provides the background of the painting.
- 2. I know the people who used to put up signs of John 3:16 in the end zone are wellmeaning, but I think it may have trivialized the love of God for some people.
- 3. Maybe this world of hatred and cynicism just trivializes the love of God!
- 4. We must never underestimate the power of God's love.
- 5. Never underestimate the power of us demonstrating his love for others.
- 6. For those who are even in the least way contemplating belief, John 3:1-17 has some exhortations for you.
- I. Don't Be Afraid to Walk Away from the Darkness
 - A. Jesus knew what was in man, 2:23
 - 1. Darkness in the human heart
 - 2. People loved darkness because their deeds were evil, 3:19
 - 3. They feared exposure to the light, 3:20
 - 4. For many it has resulted in blindness to their own evil
 - 5. Jeremiah 17:9 "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?"
 - B. Nicodemus came under the cover of darkness, 2
 - 1. Did he fear his companions in the ruling council?
 - 2. Was he afraid of losing his reputation or position?
 - 3. He tried to inject some integrity into the council, 7:50-51
 - 4. He also helped bury Christ, John 19:39.
 - 5. I think he was a man trying, in difficult times, to walk in the light.
- II. Changing Lifelong Behaviors Demands God's Power, Not Your Own
 - A. Born "from above" perhaps better than "born again"
 - 1. Nicodemus cannot understand how a person can return to his mother's womb, 4
 - 2. He confuses natural birth with spiritual birth
 - 3. NOTE: address the issue of water being the water of birth rather than baptism
 - 4. The emphasis of this discussion is on the power of the Holy Spirit
 - 5. The Holy Spirit does not operate under the parameters of the natural world though Jesus compares it to the nature of the blowing wind
 - 6. Nicodemus still doesn't understand, 9
 - B. Earthly vs. Heavenly
 - 1. Jesus elevates the discussion to heavenly matters, 10-13
 - 2. He always moves his discussions in John toward spiritual matters
 - 3. It is because of spiritual things that Jesus can offer forgiveness to a sinful woman and not so much to a Pharisee, Luke 7:36-50.
 - 4. The Pharisee cannot see beyond what she was to see what God can and wants to do for her.
 - 5. He cannot see the love of God for this "sinner."

- III. Focus Your Eyes on the Cross
 - A. History of a religious relic
 - 1. It may seem odd that a statue of a serpent could somehow represent Christ
 - 2. Numbers 21:9 Moses makes a bronze serpent on a pole to heal Israel of the plague of snakes
 - 3. The point of comparison is two-fold: the serpent was lifted up, the people who looked at it were healed
 - 4. Be careful of imposters: in 2 Kings 18:4 people mistakenly had continued to offer sacrifices to this relic centuries later
 - 5. Only Jesus provides healing because only he has been ordained by God
 - B. The Cross is the real thing
 - 1. Jesus will be lifted up, John 12:34
 - 2. The cross is the culmination of salvation history
 - 3. It represents the highest demonstration of God's love

Conclusions:

- 1. Believing and fully trusting in the kindness and love of God is the very first step that leads to the miraculous change within us.
- 2. Does not the cross epitomize the love of God, Jn. 3:16?
- 3. Story of therapist "Three Spheres" by Laura Slater in *You Can't Make This Stuff Up* by Lee Gutkind, p. 151.
- 4. Love in its many forms is the nature and power of God.
- 5. God loved us by giving his Son to die for us, John 3:16.
- 6. Believe that God loves you: this is the first step.
- 7. Until you take this step, you are still on the brink of faith.
- 8. Believe that His Son died for you.
- 9. Become a child of his by repenting and being baptized in order to be born from above.
- 10. The only thing you have to lose is the darkness in your own heart, but you gain eternal life.
